Please be aware that some vaccines require a course. You should therefore aim to start your course of vaccinations, at least 8 weeks before travel. Please complete as much of this form as possible to enable the nurse to assess your travel health requirements. **### Please hand your completed form to reception, leave it with the practice for 3 – 5 days then telephone the surgery on 01273 464640 to confirm with the receptionist which vaccinations are required, if any. ###**

*Please note: The practice runs a booked appointments system for travel vaccines, if you do not allow us and yourself enough time before you travel then we unfortunately cannot guarantee we will be able to accommodate your appointment request. In the event of this happening we would give you the contact details of a private travel clinic.*

*If you do require travel vaccines you will need to remain in the waiting room for 10 minutes after vaccination in case of side effects*
